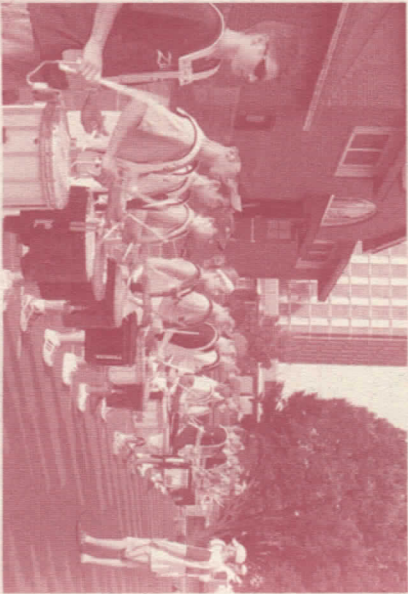

- A tee shirt and sticks/mallets are included in the program fee

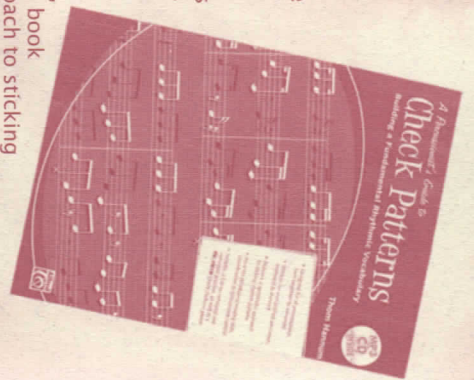
The Mobile Percussion Seminar is held in conjunction with the George N. Parks Drum Major Academy. You can send your whole band!

## A Percussionist's Guide to Check Patterns

From beginner to advanced skill levels, Thom Hannum's new book, *A Percussionist's Guide to Check Patterns*, is designed to help percussionists at any level perfect their craft. Written for non-pitched percussion, keyboard, and drumset, the book provides a systematic approach to sticking rhythm patterns – ideal for developing reading skills, coordination and syncopation control. The book is accompanied by a CD for rehearsal and individual practice, as well as a Vic Firth Check Patterns poster.



Students will work from *A Percussionist's Guide to Check Patterns* throughout the Seminar. Students are also required to use *Championship Concepts for Marching Percussion*. You may purchase these items at Seminar check-in.
