

MPS Rules & Regulations

Mobile Percussion Seminar students are expected to uphold the highest standards of behavior and attitude. Failure to comply with any of the following regulations established by the Mobile Percussion Seminar may result in immediate dismissal from the Seminar without a refund of fees. Your parent/guardian will be responsible for immediate transportation home.

1. Name tags must be worn at all times. Make sure to bring your three-ring binder, pens or pencils, and books all sessions.
2. The Mobile Percussion Seminar needs to know your whereabouts throughout the entire camp. If you feel ill at any time, you **MUST** inform an MPS staff member or TA immediately.
3. Visitation by persons who are not enrolled in the Seminar is not permitted.
4. Students are not permitted to leave campus at any time. If you drive to campus, your vehicle is to be parked, locked, and remains off-limits throughout the Seminar.
5. Please keep your room locked at ALL times. Do not leave money or other valuables anywhere on campus. The Mobile Percussion Seminar and the University of Massachusetts cannot be held responsible for loss of personal property.
6. Alcohol, tobacco (chewing tobacco, cigarettes, e-cigarettes, juuls and other vape pens) or other controlled/illegal substances are prohibited while at the Seminar. Use of any of these items is **STRICTLY PROHIBITED** and will result in immediate dismissal from the Seminar.
7. The Mobile Percussion Seminar values civility, diversity, education, equality, and honesty and we are firmly committed to maintaining a safe environment. Any type of sexual misconduct is contrary to the Seminar's policies and philosophies and will **NOT** be tolerated. Anything deemed by our Staff as

sexual misconduct will result in immediate dismissal from the Seminar, with parents/guardians being responsible for immediate transportation home.

8. Bullying/Intimidation behaviors (included, but not limited to: verbal, physical, and cyber bullying/intimidation) are strictly prohibited and will result in immediate dismissal from the Seminar.
9. Weapons of any type, including but not limited to: pocket knives/Swiss Army knives, firearms, etc. are not permitted at the Seminar. Any student in possession of any weapon(s) will be immediately reported to the Police and Public Safety and dismissed from the Seminar.
10. You may not, under any circumstances, visit the rooms or floors housing members of the opposite sex.
11. Room checks will be held each night and the time will be announced at the end of the Evening Session. At room check, you are expected to be in and stay in your assigned room.
12. Each student is asked to leave their room in the same condition at the close of MPS as when you moved in at the beginning of the Seminar. Both roommates will be held financially responsible for any cleaning or repairs that need to take place in their room as a result of their stay!
